1. How would you define God's "call"? (I.e., what do we mean when we say God *calls* us to salvation? Or, God *calls* us to a particular vocation?)
2. God does not speak to us from burning bushes, so how does God call today?
3. What means did God use to call you to your vocation?
4. How has your vocational work changed since coming to faith in Christ? How can you use your present vocation for Kingdom service?
5. Has God ever called you from one vocation to another? How did you recognize this change in direction?
6. What are some of the parallels between God's call of Moses and our call to salvation?
7. Paul refers to himself as, "an apostle—not from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father" (Gal 1:1). What does he mean when he says his calling is "*not from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father*"?
8. What are some of the results when people manufacture their own calling to ministry, or pretend to be called to ministry, or mistake their call to ministry?
9. What practical difference does it make to know that we are called (e.g., to a particular vocation or a specific area of ministry)?
10. What does God's promise, "I am with you always", mean to you personally and practically?
