2. Who has encouraged you in your pursuit of God's will? How did they encourage you? In what practical ways might we encourage others?
3. What are some of the specific ways God directs our paths?
4. Give an example from your own experience where you have seen God providentially direct your way.
5. How might we mistakenly think God is directing us someplace He really is not? What does this teach us about seeking God's direction?
6. Describe a "hardened" heart.
7. How does/should an awareness of God's fatherly love affect your daily life?
8. What was the value of Moses knowing in advance that Pharaoh would reject his message (v.21)? What lessons can we learn from this?

1. Each evening reflect on the evidences of God's guidance, power and love that you experienced during the course of that day.
2. Where do you believe God is leading you in you life at the present time? What evidence do you have of this? (See #5 above)
