1. Why is a study of the attributes of God so important for us?
2. Augustus H. Strong comments, *“The attributes have relations to each other....No one of them is to be conceived of as exercised separately from the rest. Each of the attributes is qualified by all the others.”* Explain how one attribute of God leads/links necessarily to another.
3. Why is it important that we not limit our understanding of God to one or two attributes? What are the results of such a limited understanding of God?
4. What resources would you recommend to someone who wants to do a study on the attributes of God?
5. How does God's jealousy and wrath differ from man's? In what ways should we emulate God's jealousy and wrath?
6. Louis Berkhof writes, *“The distinction between chastisement and punishment must be maintained. The Bible teaches us on the one hand that God loves and chastens His people...and on the other hand, that He hates and punishes evil-doers.”* Why is the distinction between God's just punishment and his loving discipline important for us to understand?
7. Discipline is not always to correct sin. What are some other reasons God may discipline the believer?
8. Read Hebrews 12:5-11. What are some of the important lessons to be learned from this passage about discipline?
