



## Group Discussion and Application

1. How does a realistic perspective on the sinfulness of man assist us in ministry? What happens when we don't maintain this perspective?
2. Moses faced resistance from both Pharaoh and the Israelites. Which would be more difficult to deal with? Why?
3. In what ways do we witness the power of God today? Why are these demonstrations of power so often overlooked, ignored, or explained away?
4. What does it mean to bring/give God glory? Give some examples of how we are to do this?
5. Why do you think the obedience of Moses and Aaron is so strongly emphasized? (Note the repetition and the words "just as" in 7:6).
6. What practical lessons might we glean from the ages of Moses (80) and Aaron (83) when they obeyed God (7:6-7)?
7. In the past three studies we have been learning the importance of remembering. What can we do in practice to do a better job of remembering God? Give some specific suggestions.
8. Keeping today's text from Exodus in mind, read Rom. 9:22-23 and discuss theologian J. Oliver Buswell's statement, "Sin...is permitted that the justice of God may be known in its punishment, and His grace in its forgiveness."

1. Which of the ten items of remembrance are you most prone to forget?
2. What will you do to be more mindful of this important remembrance? (See #7 above for suggestions).
3. In old age Moses and Aaron were still learning to obey God. In what area of your life are you still learning obedience? What step of obedience will you take?

2. Read Ex. 7:6-7. What do we learn from Moses and Aaron in their old age?
3. In your family prayer time, give thanks and pray for older Christians you know.
