1. Suggest some synonyms for the word "covenant". Define "covenant" in your own words.
2. In what sense is God's covenant with His people unilateral? Mutual? What is significant about each?
3. Why is it significant that the law was given to Israel after God's covenant with Abraham (Gal. 3:17-18) and after Israel was delivered from bondage in Egypt?
4. What does it mean to you personally to be a part of God's personal, treasured possession?
5. In the sermon it was stated that "*Israel was set apart not for isolation/seclusion but for mission.*" Explain. What is the application for us? What should this look like in everyday life?
6. Locate some of the great theological themes evident in our text (e.g., God's sovereignty, man's responsibility, election, salvation by grace). What other themes do you find in these verses?
7. Why do you think the same phrases describing OT Israel as the covenant people are used of the NT Church in 1Peter 2:9-10?
8. What are some of your questions about the covenants found in the Bible?

1. What is your relationship to the covenant God? Believer, what does it mean to you personally to be in a covenant relationship with God?
2. Do you own study on "covenant" this week. E.g., How is the covenant of grace that God made with Abraham and Moses & Israel continued today? How is the new covenant the same? Different? (See Heb. 7-10).
