3. What are some warning signs of spiritual drifting? What can we do to be more alert to these indicators?
4. What practical actions can we take to guard against spiritual drifting?
5. When we study the Bible, how can we make sure that we become doers of the Word and not just hearers or academic students of the Bible?
6. If those who are truly saved cannot lose their salvation, why does Scripture address severe warnings (like vv.2-3) to believers?
7. What questions do you have about this text?

2. What specific action will you take to correct these?
3. Evaluate your own devotion and attention to the saving word of Christ.
4. What changes do you need to make in order to give more careful attention to Christ’s word?
