7. The original readers of Hebrews were tempted to forsake their trust in Christ and return to Judaism. When people in our day forsake their confidence in the sacrifice of Christ, what do they go after instead?
8. What is the difference between unbelief and apostasy?
9. How would you counsel the person who fears they have committed apostasy?
